Children will continue to be supported and encouraged to sing and play instruments, performing in solo and ensemble contexts. They will further their learning of improvisation and composition, through understanding a range of high-quality live and recorded music. They will increase their aural memory through opportunities to listen with attention to detail and recall sounds.
