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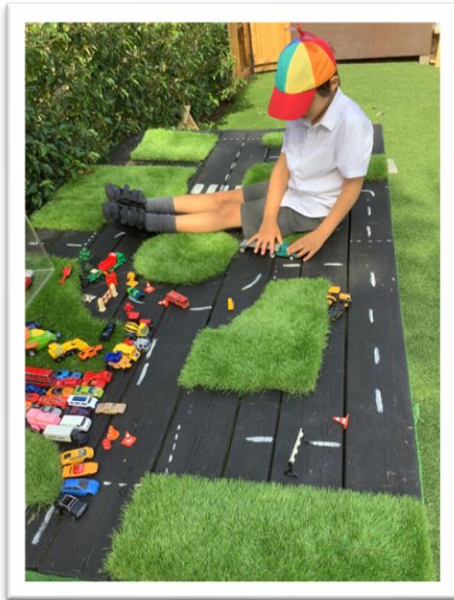
Nursery have had a great first week. They have all added a painting to the art space and have settled in very well.

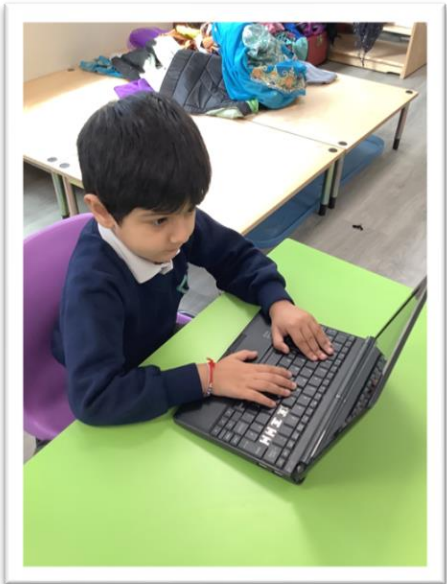

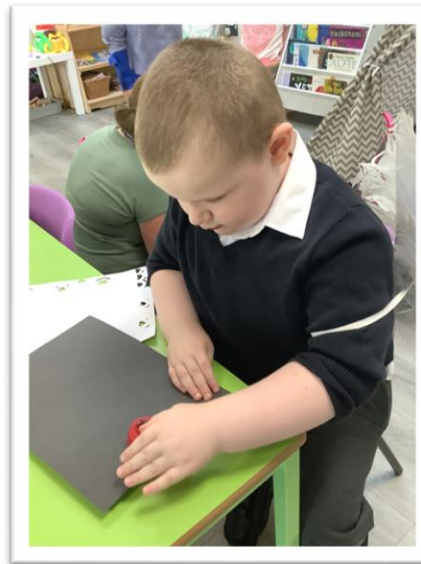

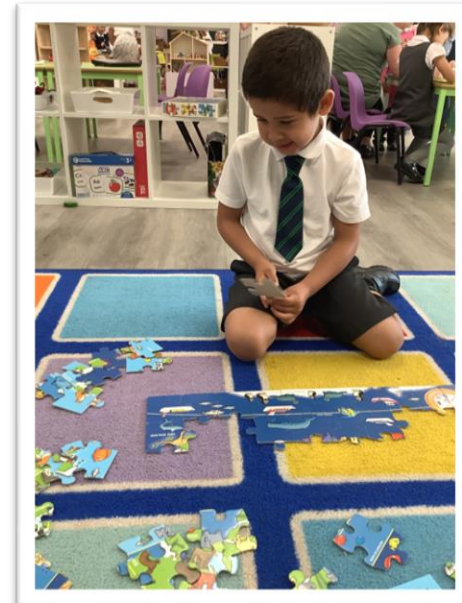

In science, Maple have been learning about Sir Isaac Newton and his role in developing the theory of gravity.

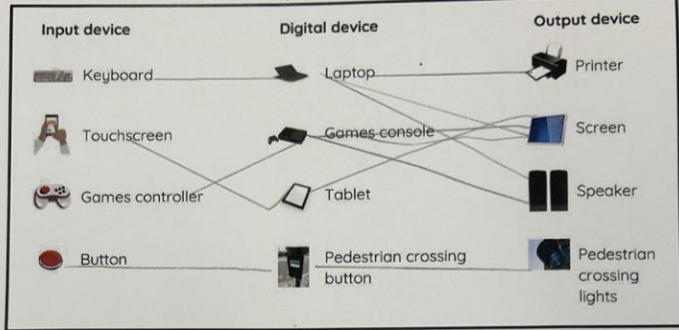
We have been measuring mass with scales and weight with Newton Metres and comparing the results.



YEAR THREE - DREW

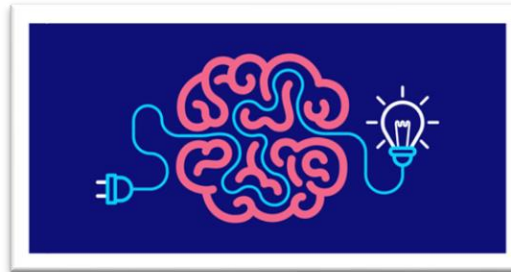
This week, Drew class explored input, process, output devices and their uses in Computing. They then had a go at inventing their own digital device. There were some weird and wonderful ideas shared!

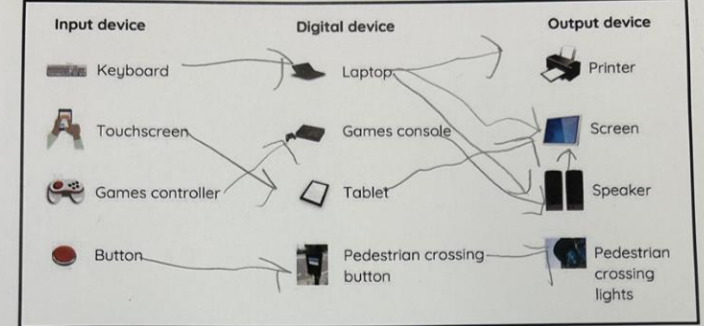

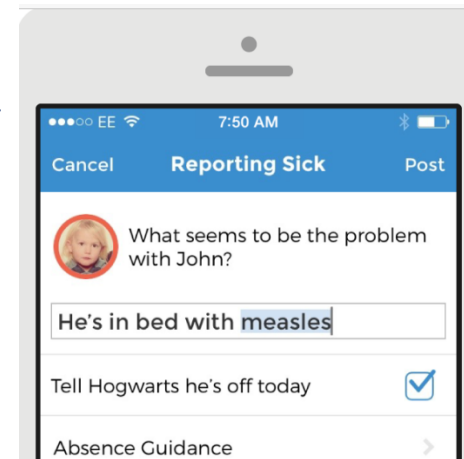
