## NOTICES: Outdoor Play and Learning - OPAL

We have started preparing for the launch of the OPAL programme which is Monday 4<sup>th</sup> December. Here's a summary of this week's changes.

- All children now have lunch between 12:00 and 13:00.
- KS2 playgrounds and the school field have been split into different zones.
- All children are now using the two KS2 playgrounds and field at lunchtime.
- Lunch time play team (teaching assistants) have been assigned to different zones.
- Rota has been introduced for children from year 2-6 for eating their dinner.
- All children can go out to play as soon as they've finished eating.

From next week we will be regularly introducing equipment into the different zones for the children to use - this week was to get the children used to the new times/zones etc.

The purpose of the programme is to improve the playtimes that the children have. By adding more equipment and allowing the children to use more of the school site all year round, their quality of play will improve.

We are going to be ordering a large numbers of wellies so the children can use the field, bushes etc all year round. We haven't got the wellies yet so if you're child wants to go on the field and in the bushes, they'll need to bring in wellies from home until the school supply is available.

For the children who get particularly muddy, you might want to send them in with a pair of waterproof trousers. We're going to be getting school pairs, but they won't arrive for a few weeks.


One of the zones is going to be a 'small world' zone where the children can use toy cars, trains, dinosaurs, dolls and teddies etc. If anyone has any of the above items that they no longer need/use, please bring them to school so we can add them to our collection.

# NURSERY 3 YEAR OLDS

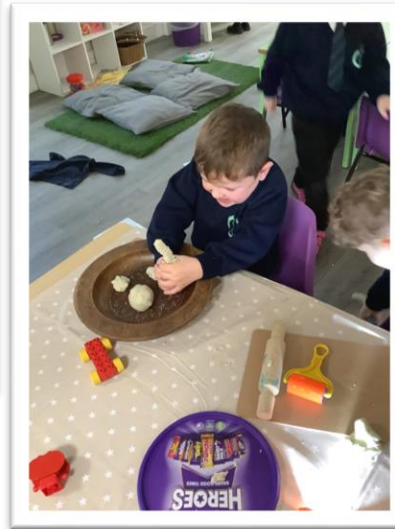

We have visited the new school library, been weaving, had a visit by an author and have been looking at timelines in History.





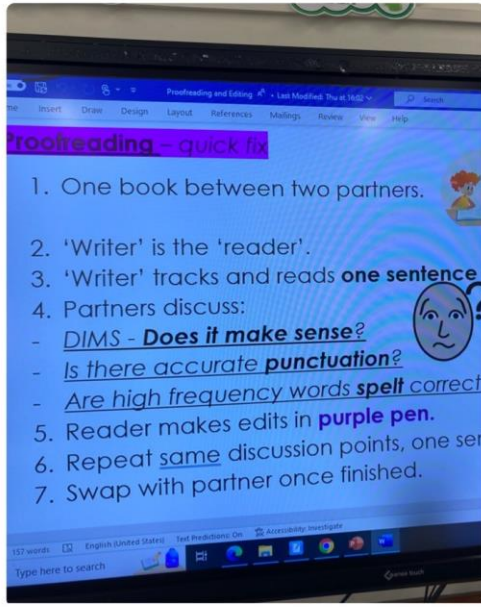
# YEAR FIVE - KING
