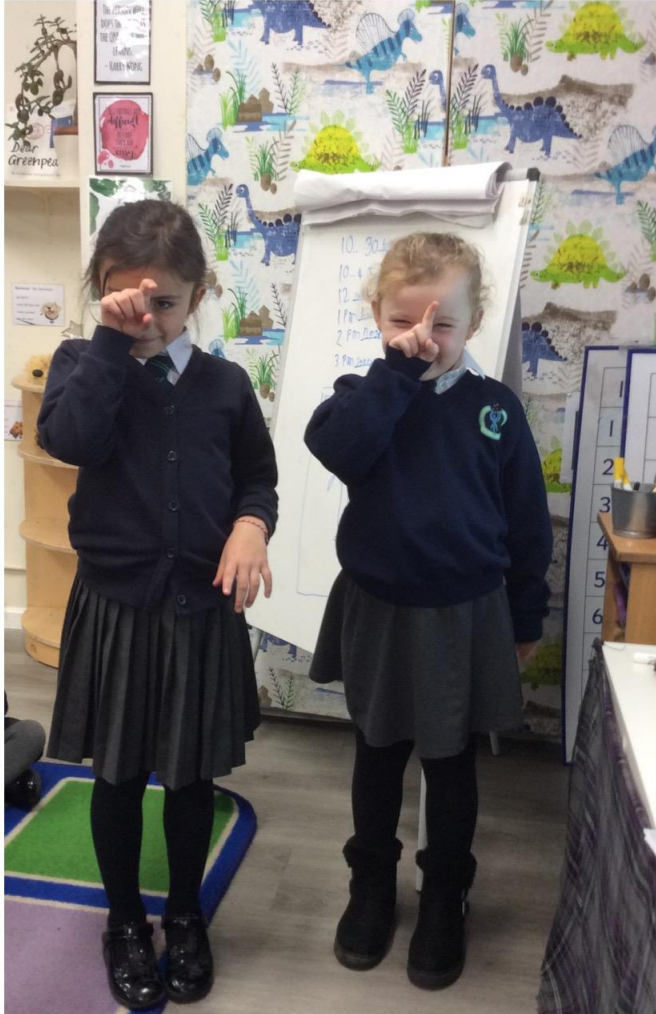
YEAR ONE - BEVAN

It's been another busy week in Reception, lots of great choosing during our learning time, building, using the water tray and independent writing, as well as lots of amazing teamwork



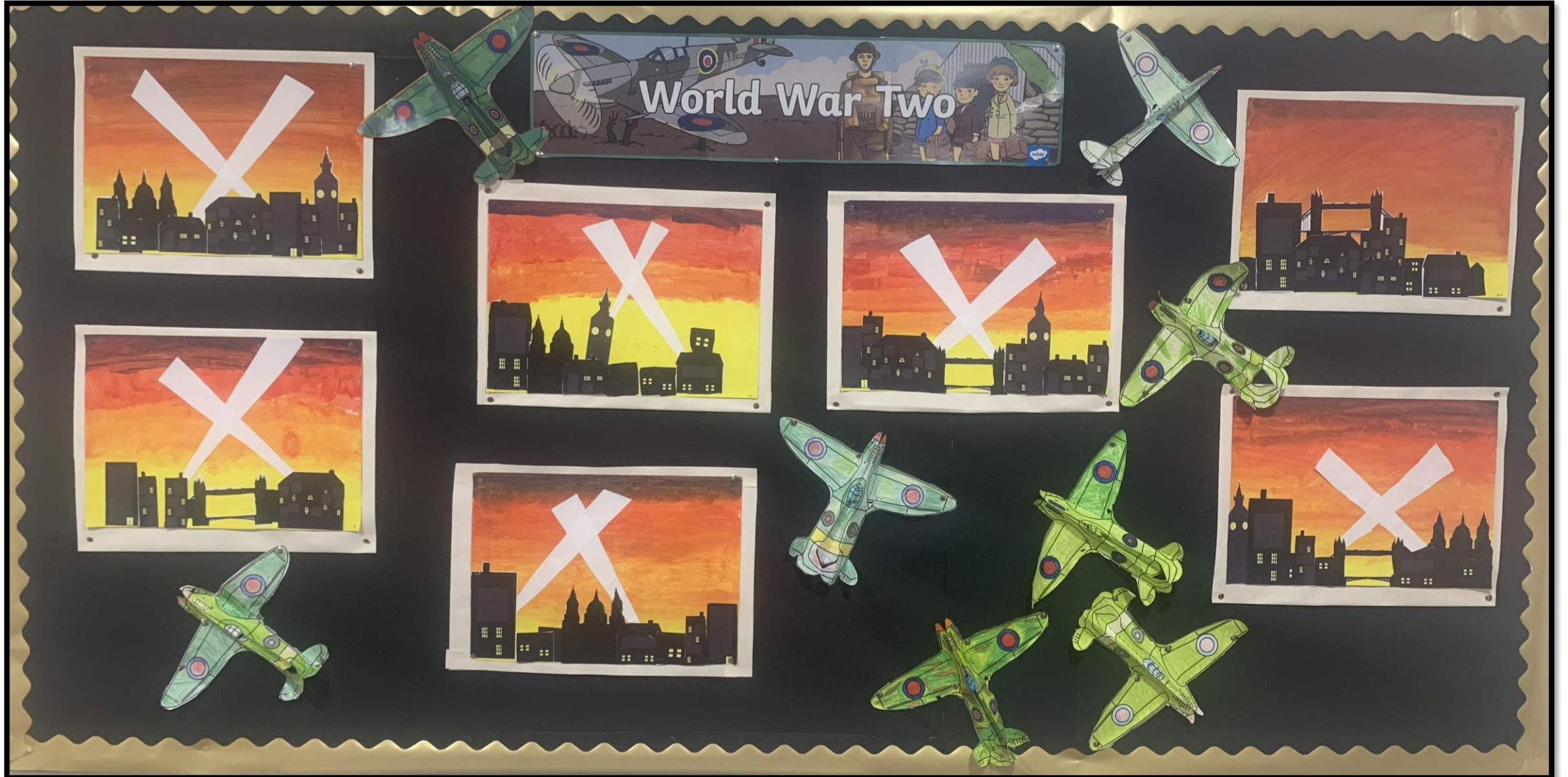
YEAR ONE - DARWIN
