This week in Mother Teresa the children have been exploring different Christmas themed media and materials to create their own pictures.

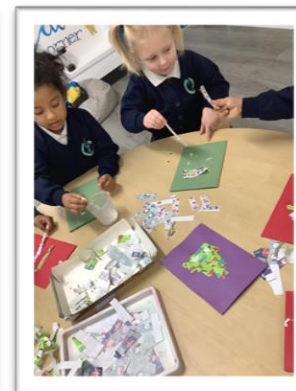


NURSERY 3 YEAR OLDS

Penguins are birds with chunky bodies and short, flat wings. These emperor penguins are the biggest type of penguin.



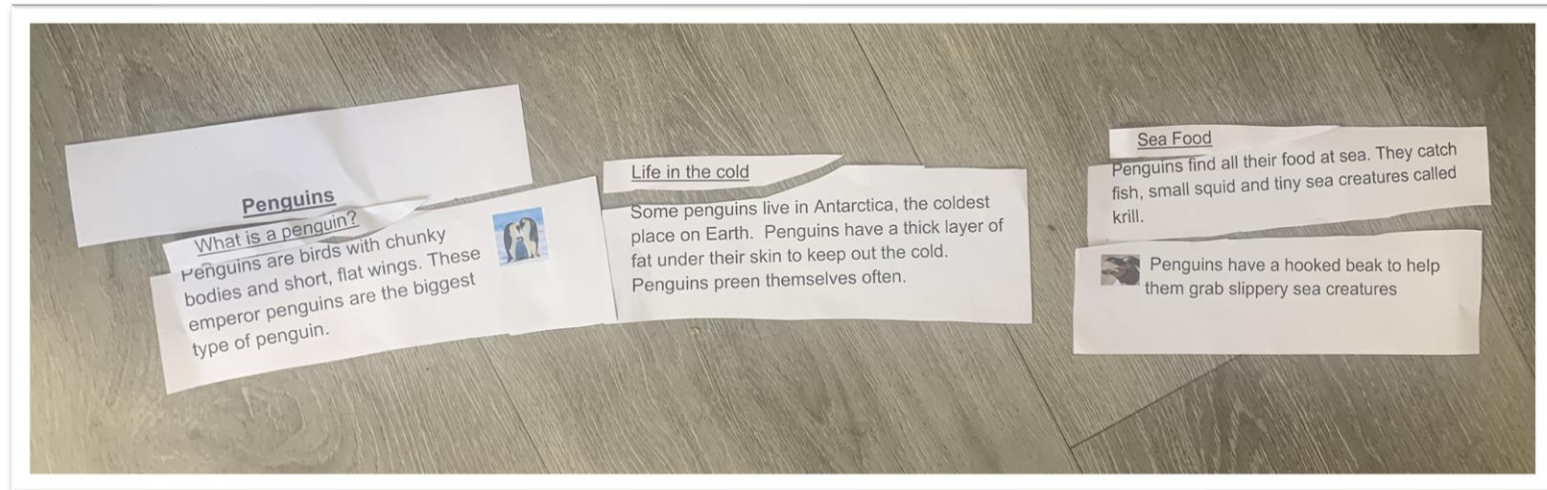
Penguins have a hooked beak to help them grab slippery sea creatures

Penguins find all their food at sea. They catch fish, small squid and tiny sea creatures called krill.

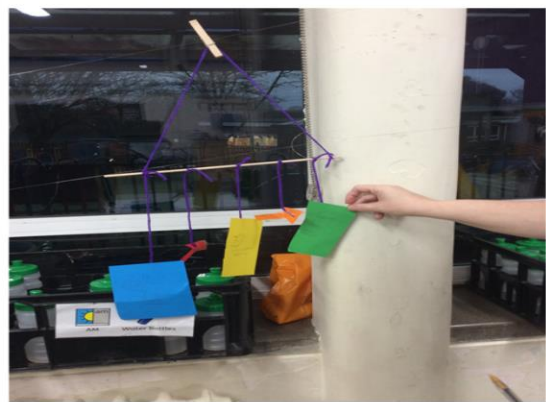
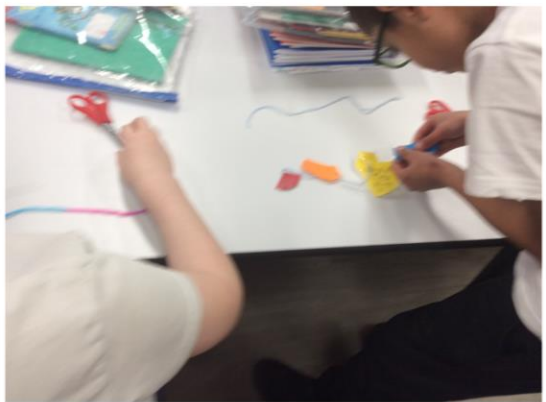
Life in the cold

Some penguins live in Antarctica, the coldest place on Earth. Penguins have a thick layer of fat under their skin to keep out the cold. Penguins preen themselves often.



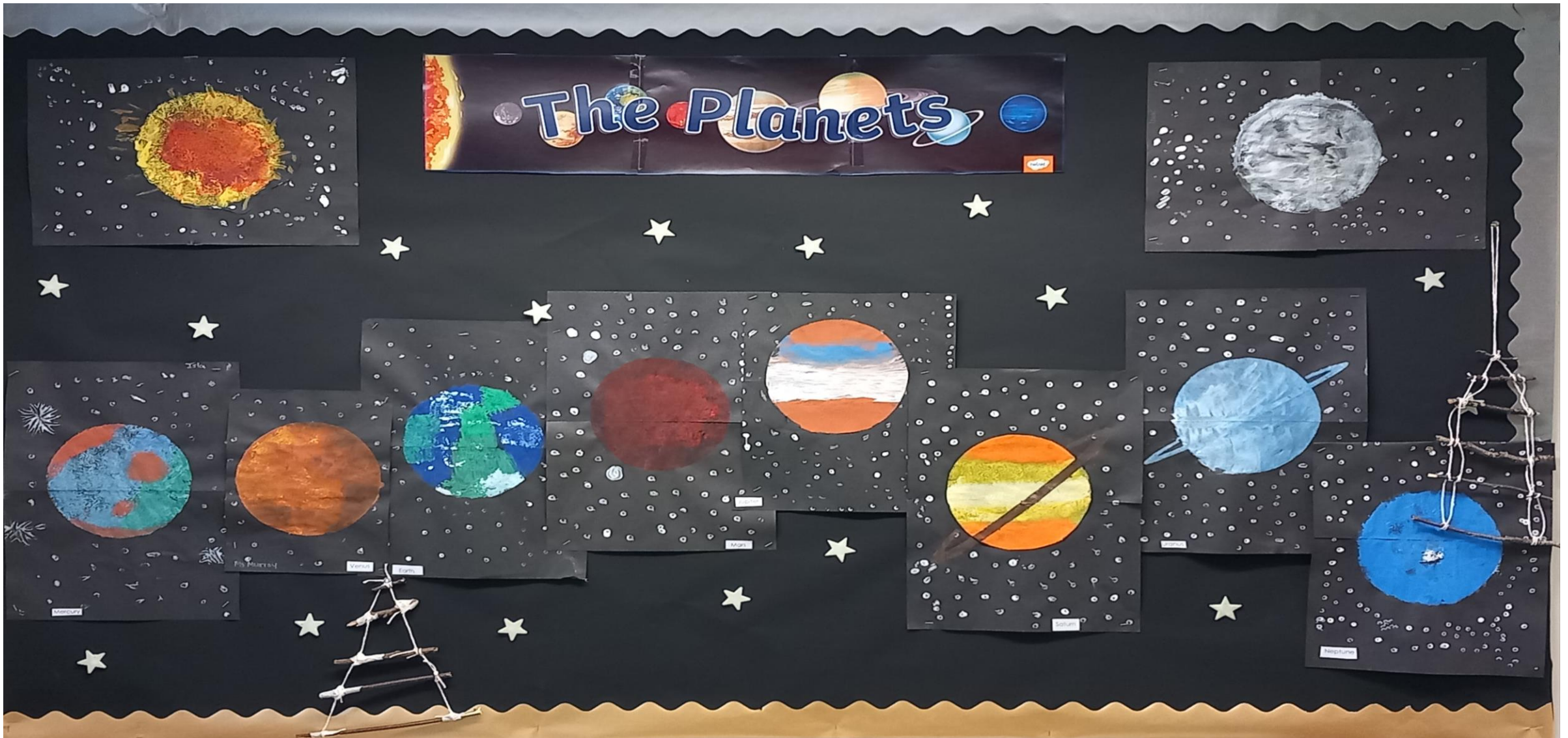
YEAR TWO - PEAKE

Maple have learning about the solar system, names of planets and the order in which they rotate the sun. They have created another fantastic display - this time for one of their classroom walls.



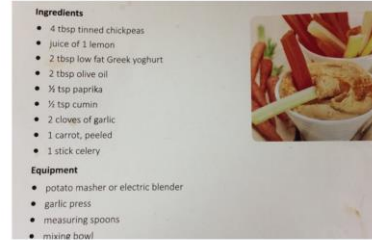
YEAR THREE DREW

Hummus with vegetable sticks

Ingredients

- 4 tbsp tinned chickpeas
- juice of 1 lemon
- 2 tbsp low fat Greek yoghurt
- 2 tbsp olive oil
- ½ tsp paprika
- ½ tsp cumin
- 2 cloves of garlic
- 1 carrot, peeled
- 1 stick celery

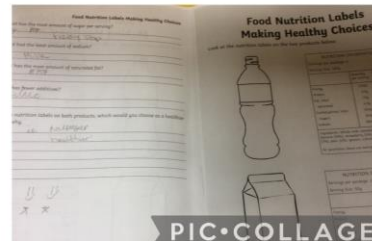
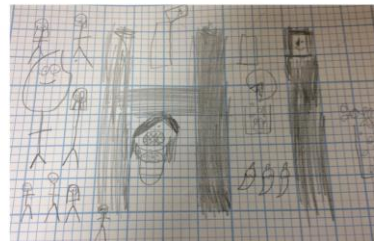
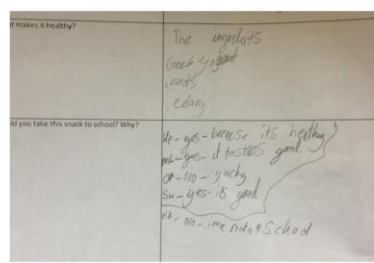
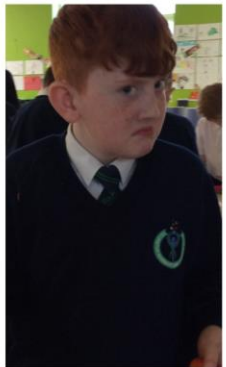
Equipment

- potato masher or electric blender
- garlic press
- measuring spoons
- mixing bowl



Method

1. Prepare the hummus by putting the chickpeas, lemon juice, yoghurt, oil, paprika and cumin into a mixing bowl or electric blender.
2. Crush the garlic in a garlic press and add to the bowl or blender.
3. Mash or blend the ingredients until smooth.
4. Prepare the vegetable sticks by cutting the carrot and celery into sticks, about 10cm long.

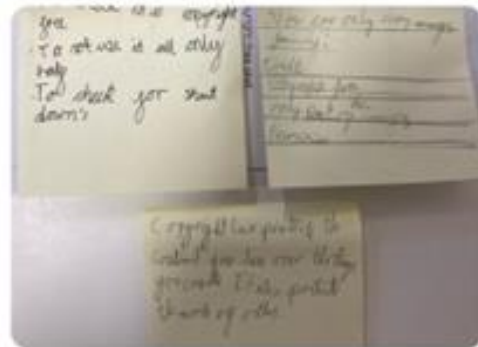
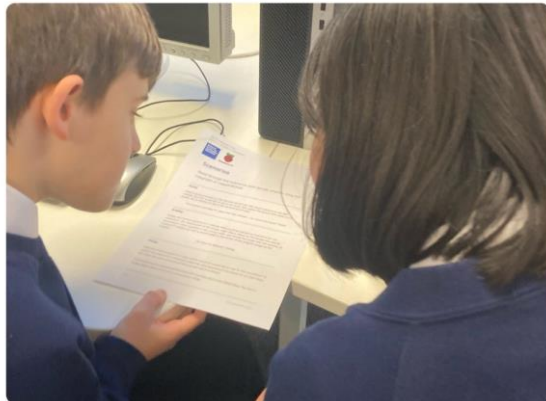
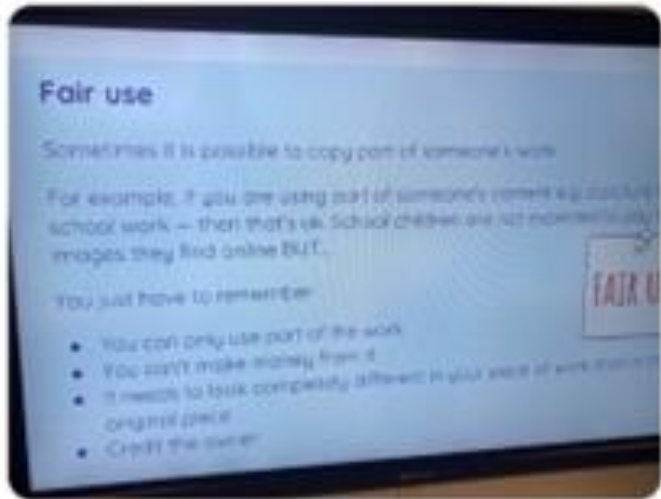
YEAR FIVE - KING
