We have counted snow men up to the number 5. We opened our imagination play our coffee shop in our garden and had lots of customers buying our coffee.






























In Maths this week Reception have been exploring ways of making 5, using part-whole models and ten frames




YEAR TWO - PEAKE


























Method

YEAR FIVE - KING




