It has been a hectic end of term, having performed in the Nativity too!



YEAR THREE DREW




Year 3 have had such a fun week! First on the agenda was to watch their stop-motion animations they made on the iPads (scan the QR code to watch their animations)!


Then they quickly got into the Christmas spirit and even made collage cards for their friends and family.
