Pluto was on the Key Stage 2 playground

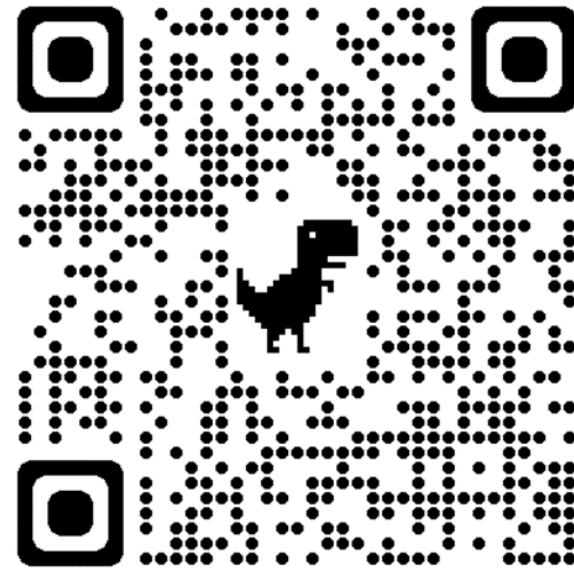




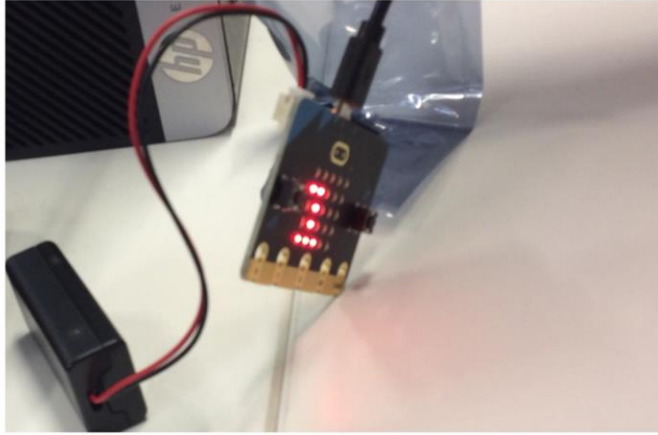
# YEAR THREE DREW

Year 3 have had such a fun week! First on the agenda was to watch their stop-motion animations they made on the iPads (scan the QR code to watch their animations)!

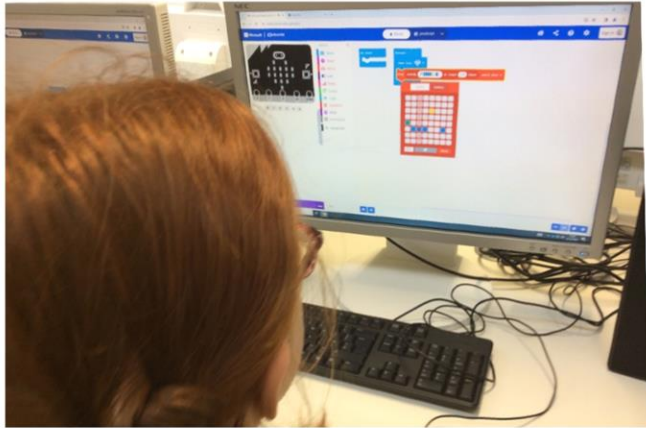
Then they quickly got into the Christmas spirit and even made collage cards for their friends and family.



# YEAR FOUR - HOPPER

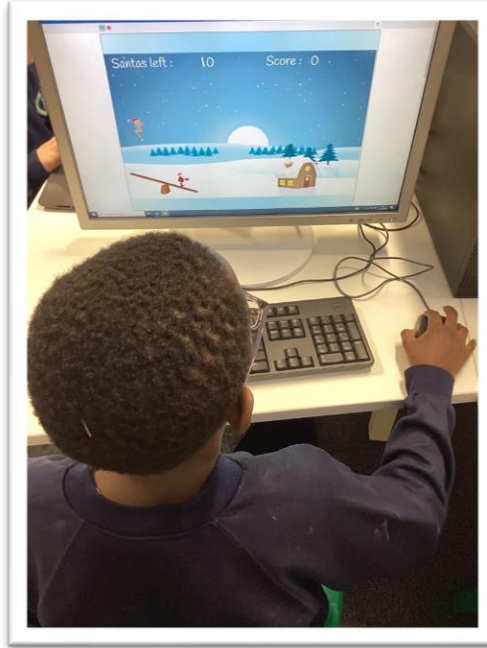
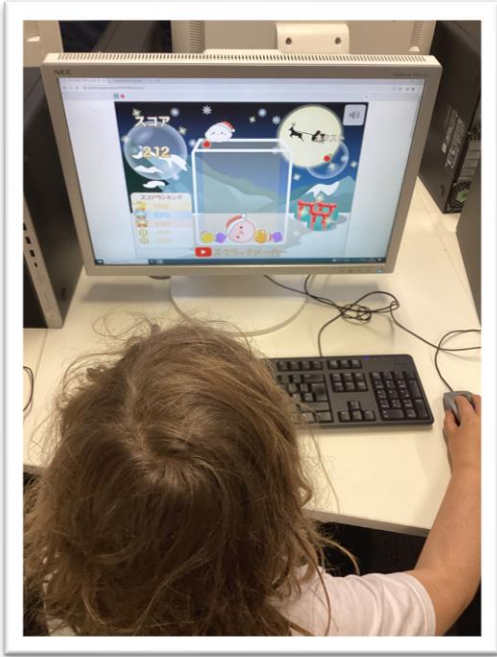


Year 4 have had fun trialling the schools new microbit computers. We even displayed a Christmas message!

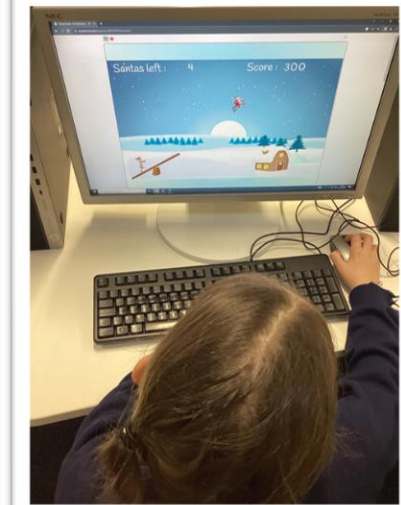
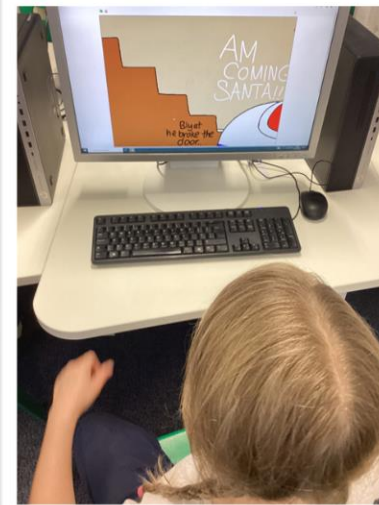
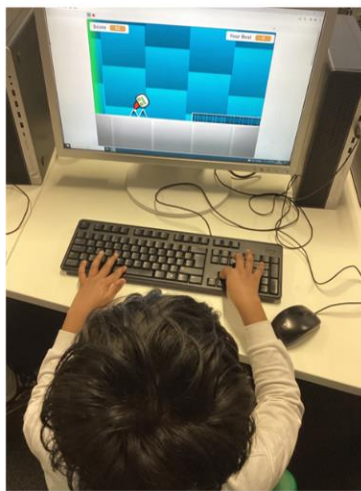




# YEAR FIVE - KING

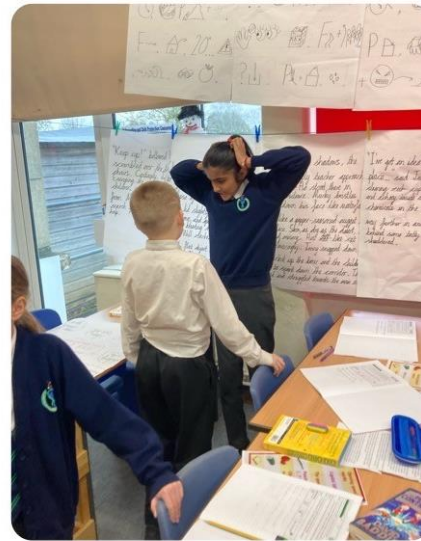

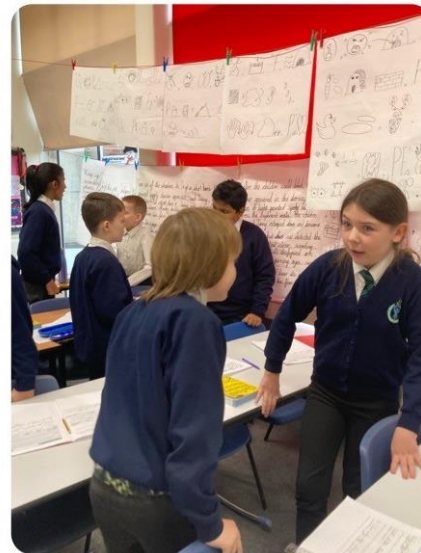




# YEAR SIX - FITZGERALD
